Firstly I would like to again thank you all for helping to keep Ducklings pre-school safe, and for all of your support during this pandemic. We really are very grateful that you are all continuing to adhere to our operating procedures. Just a little reminder that we ask for all parents/carer's to wear a face covering at all times whilst dropping off and collecting your child. Please also continue to ensure that only one parent/carer drops off/collects. This term we will be welcoming lots more families to Ducklings, we would be very grateful if you could help us to make them feel welcome, and part of our Duckling's family.

Lateral Flow Device (LFD)

I am pleased to inform you that all staff are now participating in twice weekly lateral flow tests. As a setting we feel it is paramount to do them so we can help to reduce the risk of transmission amongst each other as staff and to yourselves and your children. Of course as before if any staff test positive they will self-isolate, book a test, and follow the most recent guidance.
